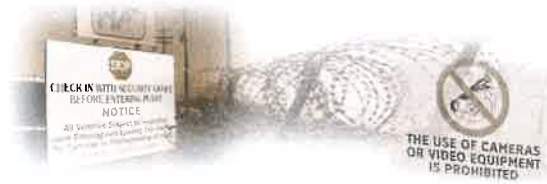

HVF West LLC is headquartered in Tucson AZ and operates DEMIL / Material Recovery facilities directly adjacent to Davis Monthan AFB in Tucson, AZ. In combination, with our railroad serviced facilities in Ohatchee, AL, HVF's shredding, and sortation capacity is in excess of 15Mlbs (Fifteen Million Pounds) monthly; to date HVF has processed in excess of 150 Million pounds of military equipment without security or performance issues

### Principal Consultant

Duties: The Principal Consultant affords a high degree of expertise on an as-needed basis at all levels of project management, organization, and planning. The Principal Consultant position, where applicable, is interchangeable with Project Manager to avoid tasking redundancy on small to medium sized projects. Principal Consultant is ultimately responsible for program approval and development and deployment initiatives, communications with government personnel and is ultimately responsible for contract completion and adherence of policies, procedures, and protocols. The position of Principal Consultant is performed solely by HVF West principals or officers experienced in all phases of operations from procurement and processing to final disposition (and/or sale) of processed materials into the secondary market. Principal Consultant possesses demonstrated daily experience in all levels of HVF operations and a successful record of accomplishment of experience with high volume "material market" transactions.

Requirements: High School Diploma and a minimum of Fifteen (15) years material recovery and/or steel industry experience is required.

### Program Manager

Duties: Manages large scale programs and/or multiple programs of varying complexity and size. The Program Manager has proven abilities of managing large-scale projects which involve a high degree of knowledge in the planning, logistic, and deployment phases. The Program Manager has proven abilities in the development of, performance-based work statements as well as demonstrated expertise in communications regarding government purchasing and sales agencies. The Program Manager analyzes project situations and expedites business and strategy plans to satisfy customer requirements. The Program Manager has the ability to translate complex performance-based requirements into operational plans, while monitoring and reviewing costs, budgets, schedules, and staffing requirements for project team. Must have excellent communication skills and a demonstrated proficiency in business communications; demonstrated expertise in Microsoft Office Suite products and certifications including MCP (Microsoft Certified Professional) and/or MCSE (Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer) are preferred.

Requirements: High School Diploma and ten(10) years' experience in contract management is required; proficiency in web-based technologies and database applications is preferred.



### **Project Manager**

Duties: Examines government customer requirements and translates these requirements into operational plans with reporting directly to HVF West Officers. Project Manager plans, directs and coordinates (on and off-site) project operations. Analyzes current and future project needs. Assists in development of performance-based Statements of Work (SOW's) and assists in translation of SOW's into procedural plans to be implemented. Project Manager is also responsible for monitoring and reporting of costs, budgets, schedules, contract modifications, change-orders, and staffing requirements.

Requirements: Associate Arts Degree and five (5) years of project management experience

### **Security Officer – Minimum of 8 Hours**

Duties: The HVF Security Officer provides armed security for the HVF West facilities and remote work sites. Officers shall maintain the safety and security of all HVF West employees, equipment, and material(s), providing coverage seven days per week, 365/6 days per year, minimum of two officers per shift. The position entails: Closed Circuit Video Monitoring provided by fixed and PTZ (Pan/Tilt/Zoom) cameras, with two 42-inch plasma monitors, which each are digitally recorded and Time/Date Stamped. Security Officers control inbound/outbound vehicle and pedestrian traffic; at all times maintaining the right to search and inspect inbound/outbound vehicle and pedestrians. Security Officers provide day and night foot patrols and surveillance 24 hrs. per day, 7 days per week, and 365/6 days per year.

Requirements: High School Diploma (or GED) and two (2) years' experience in Law Enforcement, Military, or extended Security Work experience.

### **Site Safety Consultant**

Duties: Provides oversight of material demilitarization, certification of weights and measurements. Site safety consultant performs duties on and off site and requires implementing work directives without direct oversight of project managers. The site safety consultant carries out directives issued by HVF and Officers in accordance with standard operating procedures, policies and processes as they pertain to safety of personnel, security of materials, and environmental awareness. When required, position requires coordination with government customer, HVF Management and Project Manager(s) for certification of demilitarization/destruction when required.

Requirements: High School Diploma (or GED) and two (2) years' experience.

### **Environmental Manager**

Duties: The Environmental Manager conducts ongoing oversight and support for environmental compliance issues at local, state, and federal levels and works to ensure compliance of stated company goals in the production environment. The Environmental Manager provides a working knowledge and company training with regards to ISO 14001 regulations. The Environmental Manager assists and leads initiatives with regards to permitting activities at local, state, and federal levels, and maintains a working knowledge of compliance issues with regards to emissions control; actively participating with outside sources in conducting site surveys and waste stream assessments. The Environmental Manager maintains an active role in the company's overall due diligence with regards to new opportunities and relevant permitting information. The Environmental Manager maintains a working knowledge of regulatory changes and how the changes impact the company operations. The Environmental Manager must have a demonstrated technical aptitude for problem solving, knowledge of environmental compliance, and be able to multi-task regulatory and internal company; be proficient with all Microsoft Office Suite products

Requirements: Associate Degree and five (5) years' experience in government operations where environmental issues are a component are required.

### **Equipment Operator**

Duties: Operation of equipment ranging from light industrial construction equipment to large track-hoe type excavators equipped with hydraulic shearing and demolition capabilities. Operators maintain verifiable experience in the operation of straight or articulated loaders which may be equipped with front-mounted hydraulic buckets, scoops, grapples, and a variety of attachments. HVF operators average fifteen (15) years' experience and perform "routine" maintenance; lubricating, fueling, cleaning, and safety checks. Operator must possess a thorough knowledge of heavy industrial equipment including use of specialized attachments with hydraulic shearing and demolition capabilities. Operator must possess knowledge, abilities, and skills necessary to perform essential functions in the operation and maintenance of equipment including feeding conveyors and observation of all applicable occupational safety precautions.

Requirements: High School Diploma (or GED) and Five (5) years of verifiable experience



**Site Laborer**

Duties: Laborers are skilled in the use of multiple hand tools and operate forklifts, man-lifts, mini-excavators, skid-steers, and other small equipment, when such duties are required on projects. Additional skills include, but are not limited to; installation, maintenance and repair of hydraulic shearing equipment, installation of a variety of attachments for heavy and light equipment. Identification, separation, and accounting of materials based on types, sizes and condition. Laborers are required to possess intuitive skills necessary for identification of tasks with minimal oversight and intervention. Position requires ongoing HVF Safety Training and a thorough working knowledge of the maintenance and operation of Fritz Hammermill shredding equipment in the 500-2000 HP Class with Eddy Current Separation technology. Laborers must possess a working knowledge in the readiness and preparation of (military and other) materials and equipment for processing.

Requirements: High School Diploma (or GED) and Two (2) years of verifiable.

**LLRW Handler**

Duties: LLRW Handlers are trained and Certified to government specification for the handling of ancillary materials containing small amounts of isotope materials encountered in military components prior to pick up by authorized Government RASO Agency; the LLRW Handler skills include, but are not limited to; installation, maintenance and repair of hydraulic shearing equipment, installation of a variety of attachments for heavy and light equipment. Identification, separation, and accounting of materials based on types, sizes and condition. LLRW Handlers are required to possess intuitive skills necessary for identification of tasks with minimal oversight and intervention. Position requires ongoing HVF Safety Training and a thorough working knowledge of the maintenance and operation of Fritz Hammermill shredding equipment in the 500-2000 HP Class with Eddy Current Separation technology. Laborers must possess, or gain a working knowledge in the readiness and preparation of (military and other) materials and equipment for processing or pick up.

Requirements: High School Diploma (or GED) and Two (2) years verifiable work experience

**Shipping & Receiving Clerk / Administrative Assistant**

Duties: Performs clerical tasks in relation with incoming and outgoing materials shipments. Tasks include following established HVF West procedures. The Shipping/Receiving Clerk consults with Office Administration. The Shipping/Receiving Clerk coordinates the activities of plant personnel in the day to day operations involving shipped or received materials, verification of order accuracy, comparison of Line Items and Bills of Lading; documentation verifying the identification of shipped and received goods. The Shipping/Receiving Clerk prepares and stores records of goods shipped and received through the creation and/or verification of Manifests and Bills of Lading.

Requirements: High school Diploma or (G.E.D.) and requires two (2) years' experience.

## Equipment Category Description

### **Hydraulic Excavator**

Price includes operator, fuel, specialized demolition, destruction, cutting, shearing and lifting attachments.

### **Front Loader (including operator, fuel and attachments)**

Price includes operator, fuel, specialized demolition, destruction, and lifting attachments. The front loader is a heavy machinery item used in the lifting, demilitarization, demolition, and destruction process as it applies to the specialized material recovery operation

### **Mini-Excavator (including operator, fuel and attachments)**

Price includes operator, fuel, specialized demolition and destruction attachments. The Mini-excavator is based on a Caterpillar 305C Hydraulic Excavator; this heavy machinery item is used in the destruction of smaller military items and equipment where the large excavator is not practicable.

### **Water Truck (including fuel and attachments)**

Price includes fuel, and attachments. The water truck is primarily operated by a laborer and is used as a fire suppression and safety item where cutting with torches or spark ignition of residual fuels may occur; the water truck also provides a means to suppress dust and airborne particles.

### **60' Genie Man-lift (including fuel and attachments)**

Is a self-powered portable aerial work platform designed for up to two (2) persons; used in the material recovery industry primarily for cutting and material recovery (at heights of up to 60 feet) above ground level, the Man lift is operated by laborers trained in the safe use of this device.

### **Pressure Washer 2500 PSI (heated w/ chem. injection)**

The pressure washer is operated primarily by laborers and is used in conjunction with Surface Washing Agents for the environmentally sound removal of residues from petroleum, oil, lubricant (POL) from government owned shipping containers.
